What are the National Continence Care Awards?

The expert group on lower urinary tract symptoms (LUTS), including urinary incontinence, is delighted to be hosting the inaugural National Continence Care Awards. The Awards are organised by MHP Health with funding from Astellas Pharma Ltd and will take place in the House of Commons in May 2014.

The Awards are designed to demonstrate support for ambition, excellence and leadership in continence care across the country. What is the deadline to apply?

Entry forms must be submitted by 6pm on Wednesday 9 April 2014.

Entries will be judged by representatives from the expert group on LUTS and supporting organisations listed below. Astellas Pharma Ltd will not be involved in the judging of entries.

Winners will be notified by Wednesday 23 April ahead of the presentation ceremony in Parliament on Tuesday 6 May 2014.
